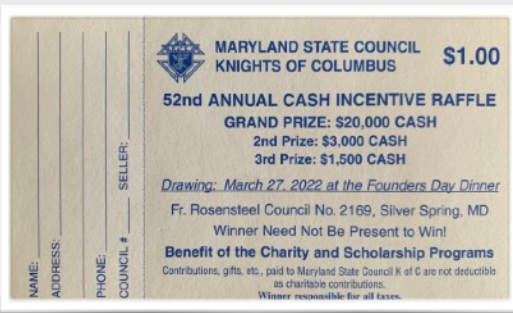
Christmas Decoration Setup

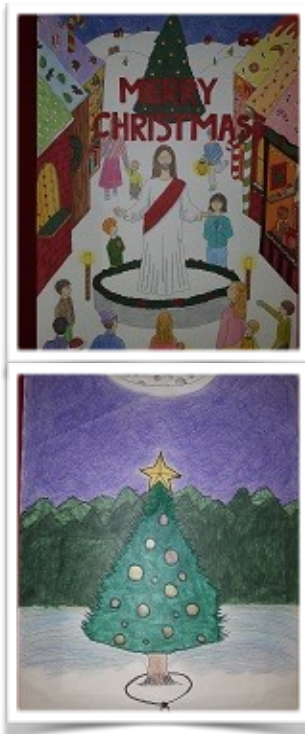
